Day 1: ARRIVAL IN SEOUL - CHECK IN - DAY AT LEISURE

- Seoul N Tower & Namsan Cable Car: Iconic landmark with a 360-degree view of the city. First multipurpose tower in Korea with sightseeing and broadcasting functions.
- Insadong Antique Shopping Alley: Largest market for traditional Korean art and products.
- Return to your hotel for the overnight stay.

Day 3: KOREAN DEMILITARIZED ZONE - HONGDAE STREET

- Enjoy a hearty breakfast at your hotel.
- After breakfast, visit the Korean Demilitarized Zone (DMZ).
- Explore the heavily fortified border between North and South Korea.

- Later visit Hongdae street, Streets filled with buskers and dance performances, providing entertainment.

- Myeongdong Shopping District : One of Seoul's primary shopping areas with a wide variety of brand-name shops and department stores.
- Later, Return to your hotel for the overnight stay.

Day 5: CHANGDEOKGUNG PALACE - SECRET GARDEN - YEOUIDO HANGANG PARK

- Start your day with a delicious breakfast at the hotel.
- After breakfast, visit Changdeokgung Palace & Secret Garden. Features a public place area, royal family residence, and a serene rear garden with a 300-year-old tree, pond, and pavilion.
- Dongdaemun Design Plaza (DDP): Famous for its futuristic architecture designed by Zaha Hadid.
- Visit Namdaemun Market: Korea's largest traditional market, established in 1964, offering a wide variety of affordable goods. Which is open overnight.
- Yeouido Hangang Park: Located in Seoul's political and financial district, attractions include Water Light Square, waterside fountains, and a riverside stage.
- Hangang River Ferry Cruise: Offers scenic views of the Hangang River, city skyline, and Banpo Rainbow Bridge.
- Later, Return to your hotel for the overnight stay.

Documents required for South Korea Visa:

1. Original passport (valid for at least 6 months from the date of return)
2. Residence visa copy continuously for last 2 years (valid for at least 6 months from the date of application)
3. Original Emirates ID and copy
4. 2 photographs (recent, Passport size 4.5 x 3.5 cm, White background, dark color dress, should not use in any previous visa)
5. Air Tickets (Musafir will arrange)
6. Hotel Voucher (Musafir will arrange)
7. Tour Itinerary - day wise (Musafir will arrange)
8. Copies of Passport/UAE residence visa & emirates ID.
9. Checklist.

If Employed:

1. NOC from Company
2. Personal last 3 months Bank statement in original with bank stamp & sufficient funds.

If Self Employed:

1. NOC from Company
2. Personal last 3 months Bank statement in original with bank stamp & sufficient funds.
3. Company Trade license copy.
