TENTATIVE ITINERARY

Day 1: ARRIVAL AT THE AIRPORT - CHECK IN - DAY AT LEISURE

- Meeting & greeting our representative at the airport.
- From the airport transfer to the hotel.
- After check-in, have some rest.
- Overnight in a hotel in Bishkek.

Day 2: BISHKEK - BURANA - CHON KEMIN (ca. 200 km, 4-5h)

- Have your delicious breakfast at the hotel.
- At 10:00 we pick-up cars from the hotel and start our journey.
- To leave the city, we just need to drive through two main streets. After passing two traffic lights, we will find ourselves outside the city.
- First, the route takes us into the mountains to the Issyk-Ata ridge; Many interesting mountain serpentes and beautiful views await us.
- Our journey continues with a visit to the Burana Tower.
- The Burana Tower is an ancient minaret in the Chuy Valley in the north part of Kyrgyzstan.
- The tower with funerary monuments, earthworks, remains of the castle and three mausoleums – that's all what last out of the ancient Balasagyn town that was founded by Karakhanids at the end of the ninth century.
- We will have lunch at the local family guesthouse.
- Then we are going to Chon Kemin valley.
- There, the locals show you the famous national horse game Kok Boru.
- Kok Boru showcases the skill, strength, and horsemanship of its participants, providing a unique and captivating experience for those seeking a taste of Central Asian culture.
- Rest and dinner at the guest house in luxe twin rooms.

Day 3: CHON KEMIN - CHOLPON ATA (ca. 200 km, 3-4h)

- After enjoying a hearty breakfast at the guest house, we start at 9:00, warming up our 'iron horses.' Passing through the Boom Gorge, we enter the Issyk-Kul region, home to Kyrgyzstan's largest lake.
- We pass the Boom gorge and enter the Issyk-Kul region, the homeland of the biggest lake of Kyrgyzstan.

- Lake Issyk-Kul was a stopover on the Great Silk Road, the land route of travelers from the Far East to Europe.
- We will continue our journey along the northern shore to the resort town of Cholpon-Ata.
- Upon arrival in Cholpon Ata, lunch at a local restaurant.
- In the evening we will take a boat trip (1 hour) to enjoy the beautiful sunset on the pearl of Issyk- Kul and majesty of the snow-capped mountains of Tien Chan.
- You can enjoy the freshness of the local air and the beauty of the natural landscape.
- Dinner at a local restaurant.
- Rest at the hotel.

Day 4: CHOLPON ATA - GRIGORIEV AND SEMENOV GORGES - KARAKOL (ca. 180 km, 3-4h)

- Have breakfast at the hotel. We will depart at 10:00 a.m.
- Today we go towards Grigoriev and Semienov gorges. They are located on the northern shore of Issyk Kul Lake, 60 kilometers from Cholpon Ata.
- These places are considered as the most famous attractions in Issyk-Kul.
- You can hear the noise of the mountain river with glacial clear water, which flows down to the valley.
- The middle part of the valley is crowned with two snowy peaks: the peak of Kum-Bel (4200 m) and Eshenbulak peak (4647m).
- Lunch at a local restaurant.
- Later we arrive in Karakol, located directly at the base of the majestic Terskey Ala Too mountain range and considered the main settlement of the Issyk Kul region.
- Here we will visit its famous sights such as the Orthodox Church and the Dungan Mosque.
- In the evening we will have dinner at the hotel accompanied by a national folklore show.
- You will discover music that reflects the life of Kyrgyz nomads.

Day 5: KARAKOL - DJETY - OGUZ - BARSKOON - SKAZKA - BOKONBAEVO - KOCHKOR (ca. 320 km, 5h)

- Have breakfast at the hotel. Departure at 9:00 a.m.
- A long day ahead with several visits along the way such as Jety Oguz (from Kyrgyz it is translated - 'Seven Bulls'.)

- Dense vegetation covers the red rocks of the gorge. The name 'Seven Bulls' follows from Red Rocks, being on against a sanatorium, which is known for the medical hot springs.
- Next place is Barskoon gorge is known for its beautiful and powerful waterfalls. The most famous are the Bowl of Manas, the Leopard Tears, located at an altitude of 2,500 m above sea level, at a distance of 12 km from Barskoon village.
- We will have lunch at Tamga village.
- After that we visit Skazka canyons, which signify Fairytale.
- Here you can find objects of surprising shapes and sizes. A real skyscraper or an animal may appear in front of you while you walk and explore this place.
- In Bokonbaevo you will get acquainted with an eagle hunter with his bird of prey.
- Eagle hunting is one of the oldest traditions of the Kyrgyz nomads.
- Upon arrival in Kochkor, you will try to have a master class on cooking Boorsok. Boorsok is a traditional Kyrgyz flour product, made of fried dough.
- Dinner and overnight at the hotel.

Day 6: KOCHKOR - BISHKEK (ca. 360 km, 6h)

- After breakfast at the guest house, you will take part in a traditional felt show, where we will be told all the secrets of making shyrdaks - Kyrgyz felt carpets included in the UNESCO World Heritage List.
- The manufacture of felt products is an ancient craft of nomadic peoples.
- Then we will return to Bishkek. On the way we will stop to taste the traditional bakery product kattama.
- Upon arrival, we will have a short tour of the city of Bishkek, we will visit the heart of the city, Ala-Too Square, where all events of national importance are held.
- Dinner at a local Indian restaurant.
- Rest overnight at the hotel.

Day 7: TRANSFER TO AIRPORT

- After Breakfast at the Hotel. (depending upon departure)
- Proceed to check out from the hotel and transfer to the airport.
